

LMUN IDEA FAIR 2024 (5th Edition)

MODALITIES AND GUIDELINES



Having completed registration for the Lagos Model United Nations Conference by the payment of registration fee, and indicated interest in participating in the idea fair by filling the registration form. Please take note of the following information.

- The Idea Fair is a two-staged competition. It shall comprise of A Preliminary round and A Final round. At the preliminary stage, delegates are expected to send in their project proposal on the subject matter of their choosing but in compliance with the specifications provided below.
- The Idea Fair committee will scrutinize and analyze all project proposals and shortlist finalists who will be contacted and called upon to make appearance at the final round during Lagos Model United Nations 2024 Conference. The assessment of the committee is FINAL and CANNOT be challenged by delegates.
- The final presentation will take place during the Conference during which the judges of high expertise in the project areas will inspect, make inquiries, and probe into the strength of the proposals of the shortlisted finalists.

The Preliminary Stage: Rules for Participation

Select one of the subject matters of your choice (attached to this is a document containing the approved subject matter areas and a brief analysis on these selected areas). Your idea must be centered on these approved topic areas.

- Select one of the subject matters of your choice (attached to this is a document containing the approved subject matter areas and a brief analysis on these selected areas). Your idea must be centered on these approved topic areas.
- Draw up a proposal on your idea which must be practicable, entrepreneurial and strategic, containing an implementation strategy with regards to your chosen subject matter. The project is not limited to only ideas and may be based on initiatives that are beyond ideation stage.
- The proposal MUST comply with the following FORMAT specifications:
 - Microsoft Office document of not more than 10 pages
 - Double line spacing
 - Font: Times New Romans. Font Size: 12
 - Cover page should contain the name of the delegate and subject matter of the proposed idea ONLY.
- All proposals must be submitted to asg1@lmun.ng on or before the 21st of August 2024.
- All proposals must be detailed and explicit as regards idea and content, this will be critically assessed and would ultimately determine whether or not it will be shortlisted for the final presentation during the Conference.
- Failure to comply with any of these Rules will lead to the deduction of marks or disqualification.

CRITERIA FOR ASSESSMENT AND AWARD

The proposed ideas of the delegates with regard to the project topics will be assessed based on the following criteria;

- Ingenuity
- Entrepreneurial acumen
- Pragmatism
- Sustainability

Delegates will be assessed by Judges from partner companies / NGOs specialized in the project areas and the delegate with the best project plan will be awarded the sum of N300,000 for the kick-off and implementation of the project. The Partner NGO can further fill into an advisory role for the project's implementation (subject to their discretion).

The assessment of the judges at the final presentation is FINAL and delegates CANNOT challenge it. At the end of the process, the candidate with the most creative, pragmatic and sustainable project in any of the subject matter areas will emerge the winner of the Idea Fair contest.

Accordingly, delegates are to adhere to the following instructions and conditions for their participation.

Conditions for Participation

- Only registered delegates who have paid their registration fees are eligible to participate in the Idea Fair.
- Interested delegates are to register for the idea fair by indicating interest on the idea fair registration form after which a mail will be sent to them on the modalities of the competition.
- Delegates are to choose ONE of the project topics upon which their project plans and proposals will be made.
- Delegates are required to come up with innovative, pragmatic and sustainable ideas on their choice project topic. The project is not limited to only ideas and may be based on initiatives that are beyond ideation stage.
- Delegates are to send in their proposals on or before the 21st of August,
